Salat is the main and central pillar and the core worship in Islam. Its acceptance is vital for spiritual elevation. This Book deals with the basic requirements for the validity of our Salat, which are essential for its acceptance. It covers various ways, to improve the quality of our prayers to the levels required to attain the state of "Me'raj", the spiritual elevation, as the Prophet (s) said. If we fail to attain that stage, we lose the core benefits Salat can bring in us, which are, among others, mental tranquility, self-reformation and self-purification. (Q. 13:28)

Two chapters on Salatul Jama'ah and Salatul Jumu'ah have been included as both of these salats form important features of our daily and weekly worship and a strong spiritual and social structure of Islam. The Chapters contain common and essential "Masael", explained in simple and plain words, for the validity of our Salat. It is extremely important that we learn these rules.


Otherwise, the validity our prayers will be at risk.





The Prophet Muhammad , as the 'founder' of Islam and the messenger of Allah's (God's) final revelation to mankind, is the interpreter par excellence of the Qur'an. His Hadith and Sunnah - his sayings and actions - are, after the Noble Qur'an, the most important source of Islamic belief and practice.

For many people, the earthly career of the Prophet seems often 'too human' and 'too engrossed' in the vicissitudes of the social, economic and political aspects of daily activity to serve as a model for the ideal spiritual life. Because of this, many people who write of the great spiritual guides of humanity can not understand and interpret him without bias. The Prophet participated in all aspects of social life - he married, had a family, was a father and moreover, was a ruler and a judge. He also had to fight many battles in which he experienced the painful outcomes of war - in essence, he had to experience all the difficulties which human life entails. However within all of these activities, his heart rested in contentment with the Divine and he continued to repose in the Divine Peace. In fact, his participation in social and political life was precisely to integrate this domain into a spiritual centre!


It was the function of the Prophet to be not only a spiritual guide, but also the organizer of a new social order with all that such a sytem requires, and it is precisely this aspect of his being that veils his purely spiritual dimension from foreign eyes.

Outsiders have understood his political genius, his power of oratory, and his great statesmanship, but few have understood how he could be the religious and spiritual guide of humanity and how his life could be emulated by those who aspire proximity to the Almighty Creator. From the Muslim point of view, the Prophet is the symbol of perfection of both the human person and human society. He is the prototype of the human individual and the human collectivity and as such, he bears certain characteristics in the eyes of the Muslims which can only be discovered by studying the accounts of conduct and behaviour - as seen in this monumental work, Sunan an-Nabi.

The transition to the Hereafter is a journey to be undertaken by all. To understand the whole journey requires an appreciation of the process of death itself. There are systems to be put in place during and after the process of death.

Questions have always been the key to unlocking the treasures of knowledge, and individuals and nations who tend to question less, acquire a reduced share from this vast treasure. Without doubt, it is the right of every person to ask questions and obtain their answers, and none can be deprived of this logical and rational priviledge. The Noble Qur'an has repeatedly emphasized this right and in order to better understand our faith, we have been ordered to ask those who possess knowledge.

The breadth of this Qur'anic ruling reveals that Islam does not recognize any limits or restrictions as far as questioning is concerned and permits everyone to pose questions in connection with doctrinal, social, ethical, political and other issues. The obvious exception to this rule are misleading questions asked with the intention of ruining peoples' faith, and those asked merely to plant confusion in the minds of the people. In reality, these are not questions, rather they are destructive plots in the guise of questions.

Since the Noble Qur'an is a colossal encyclopaedia of Divine sciences and human affairs, on numerous occasions and in connection with various verses, there are questions that come to the forefront - a great number of which, due to lack of relevance of the subjects discussed, remained unanswered in the books of commentary of the Qur'an.

This book, which is presented in three parts, is a compilation of 180 questions and answers covering a wide spectrum of issues from the daily practical rulings of Islam (Fiqh), historical issues, theological beliefs and other topics, which Muslims have been perplexed about for hundreds of years.


